OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Economy - Barring ISD facility while
retaining STD facility.

The officers of and above the rank of Joint Secy. are allowed the facility of STD at their office^{telephones} as well as residential telephones vide O.M. No.7(20)/E.Coord./79 dt. 27th Oct., 1979 and 7(12)/E.Coord/87 dt. 28th Oct. 1987. A ceiling of 650 calls on monthly basis has been fixed vide OM No.7(8)/E.Coord/82 dt. 6th June, 1982. Calls in excess of 650 (excluding STD calls made for official purpose and so certified by the officer concerned w.r.t. register maintained by him) are required to be paid by the officer concerned. The telephone lines having STD facility can also be made use for ISD facility. With a view to curtailing wasteful expenditure in the Government, it has been decided to bar ISD (International Subscriber Dialing) facility while retaining the STD facility on the offices as well as the residential telephones of the Offices eligible for STD facility.

2. The Ministries/Departments are requested to bar ISD facility while retaining the STD facility wherever STD facility has been made available.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Residential telephone - refixation of ceiling for free calls.

.....

The undersigned is directed to say that as provided in para-1(iii) of this Ministry's O.M.No.7(20)-E(Coord)/79 dated 27th October, 1979, payment for 1000 calls per quarter in respect of residential telephone of an officer is made by Government and the payment for calls in excess of this limit is to be made by the officer concerned. From 1.3.1982, the P&T Department has revised the rates of local and rental call charges. The local calls metered on or after 1.3.1982 will be billed for on bi-monthly basis from the bills to be issued from 1.4.1982 and onwards. In view of the re-scheduling of the billing cycle from quarterly to bi-monthly basis, the question of refixing the ceiling on free calls has been considered. It has been decided that with effect from 1.3.1982 the ceiling on free calls to be allowed to officials in respect of residential telephones provided at Government expense will be 650 on bi-monthly basis. Calls in excess of 650 (excluding STD calls made for official purposes and so certified by the officer concerned with reference to the register maintained by him) will have to be paid by the officer himself. In the case of husband and wife sharing the same residential telephone, the revised ceiling on calls will be 1300 on bi-monthly basis.
