

**Monthly Summary for the month of July, 2018**

Important events for the month of July, 2018 are as follows:

1. During the month, Brahmaputra Cracker & Polymer Limited (BCPL) has produced 27,086 MT of Polymers and 5,381 MT of Liquid Hydrocarbons. 24,371 MT of Polymers and 7,183 MT of Liquid Hydrocarbons have been sold during the month.
2. During the month of July, 2018, 3766 students completed their skill training through short term training programmes at different centres of Central Institute of Plastics Engineering and Technology under its Skill Development Activities.
3. The 32<sup>nd</sup> centre of CIPET was inaugurated jointly by Hon'ble Minister, Chemicals and Fertilizers and Hon'ble Chief Minister of Utrakhand, at Doiwala, Dehradun on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2018. The total project cost is around Rs. 51.32 crore shared on 50:50 basis between the State and Govt. of India. The centre aims to provide technology support to plastics and allied industries in the State and train technically skilled manpower for the sector. An existing building of ITI has been renovated by the State Government to commence the activities and allotment of 10 acres of adjacent land is in process for permanent building of the centre. Around 1360 manpower is expected to be trained in the first year.
4. Meeting of Hindi Salahkar Samiti of the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers was held on 16.07.2018 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Chemicals and Fertilizers, Shri Anant Kumar. In the meeting, the progress of Hindi in official work in the Department and its undertakings/institutions was reviewed.
5. Following three competitive activities on Swachhta have been launched on MyGov platform:-
  - I. Slogan Writing Competition on "Bringing out the Positive Role of Plastics and removing the negativity around use of plastics"
  - II. Paragraph Writing Contest on "Success Stories: Positive impact of plastics in the daily life of citizens".
  - III. An Innovative Challenge/ Crowd Sourcing idea for "Managing Plastic Waste for a better environment- Solutions for Origin-to end disposal".

These contest will remain open for the participants by the end of August, 2018.

6. In the month of July, 2018, 08 grievances were brought forward and 28 grievances were received, of which 25 have been disposed of. Of the remaining 11 grievances, no grievance is of more than 90 days pendency.
